RULES:

Encourage everyone to switch off your lights for one hour, Saturday 27 March 8:30 pm

- Submissions can be either a photo or drawing.
 - Digital photos or scanned in drawings can be posted on-line at Greenrock's Earth Hour website – select the tab on the Home Page called, '*Share Earth Hour*'
 - Hardcopy pictures and drawings can be dropped of in the Earth Hour Box at City Hall, Hamilton
- Each submission must be accompanied by a note stating the name of the person, their age, and what school they attend. The Note should explain how they participated in Earth Hour 2010. The note should not be longer than 100 words.
 - For digital submissions, when posting your image, there is a text box that you can type in your Note.

JUDGING AND PRIZES:

- Entries will be arranged based on four age bands:
 - Ages 5 to 6
 - Ages 7 to 10
 - Ages 11 to 13
 - Ages 14 to 18
- There will be four (4) prizes for each age category
- Each submission will be judged by the Earth Hour Implementation and Planning Council on the unique way how you participated in Earth Hour and how creative you are in capturing the essence of this event.
- Winners will be announced in the Press on April 7th and will be contacted individually to collect the prize. A group photo will be taken of the winners and used by Greenrock for Earth Hour promotions.
