Life Cycle Approach


Our goal is to reduce environmental impact at every stage of a product's lifecycle.








KCP Uses More Recycled Fiber than Virgin Fiber!



How we did it?


- KCP "decorated" the back of the house bathrooms promoting the message that we all can be part of the solution by reducing usage of the products.
