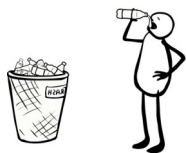
5:00PM: THE STORY OF STUFF

6:00PM: THE STORY OF BOTTLED WATER

The Story of Bottled Water explores the bottled water industry's attacks on tap water and its use of seductive, environmental-themed advertising to cover up the mountains of plastic waste it produces.
